

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (BRAMLEY ROAD, SILCHESTER) NOTICE 2016**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 considers that the closure specified below should come into force without delay:-

**Road Affected:-**

Bramley Road, Silchester, outside Brook Farm – between the junction of Bramley Road / Church Lane and the junction of Bramley Road and Clappers Farm Road (also Minchens Lane) for approximately 2100m with access due to Dig location being at Brook Farm Only

**Effect of Notice:-**

To temporarily close Bramley Road, Silchester, from 4 to 8 March 2016

**Reason for Closure:-**

Works will be undertaken to allow for the repair of a burst water main.

**Alternative Route:-**

Bramley Road, Church Lane, Clappers Farm Road, Bramley Lane

**Period of closure:-**

The closure will come into effect on 4 March 2016 for 5 days.
